Monthly Plan Premium for People who get Extra Help from Medicare to Help Pay for their Prescription Drug Costs

If you get extra help from Medicare to help pay for your Medicare prescription drug plan costs, your monthly plan premium will be lower than what it would be if you did not get extra help from Medicare. This is called Low-Income Subsidy (LIS). The amount of extra help will be determined by your total monthly plan premium as a member of SECUR Health Plan.

This table shows you what your monthly plan premiums will be if you get extra help.

*You stay in this stage until your total out-of-pocket costs reach \$2,100.
